## LEVEL 1

### Building Intercultural Relationships - Learning to See

In this introductory workshop, participants will acquire a repertoire of practical skills for building healthy and ethical intercultural partnerships in varied contexts. Participants will engage in a simulation exercise designed to transfer their intercultural skills to an unfamiliar cultural environment.

## LEVEL 2

### Building Intercultural Dialogue - Learning to Understand

The intermediate workshop further develops the capacity of participants to build strong communicative relationships with individuals from different cultures. Learners acquire a second set of skills that give them deeper insight into dynamics of a specific culture. A practice case study will end the day.
